She also undertook ProBono work, notably representing families in appeals against school exclusions (via the School Exclusion Project). In addition, during her legal studies she volunteered with Advocate (formerly the Bar ProBono Unit), Liberty, and various law clinics, gaining experience across a breadth of civil work. Jessica will consider cases on a ProBono basis.

Jessica studied biomedical sciences, where she graduated with a first-class degree. In her legal studies, Jessica obtained a distinction in both the GDL and Bar Course, and was supported by Inn and institution scholarships.

## Personal Injury

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Jessica regularly appears in, or advises on, public liability and employer liability claims, and claims involving road traffic accidents. Jessica accepts instructions for both claimants and defendants.

She appears in court several times a week in both liability and quantum disputes, including cases with issues such as fraud and provisional damages. She is an experienced courtroom advocate, with further instructions in preliminary hearings, disposal hearings, stage 3 hearings, and infant approval hearings.
