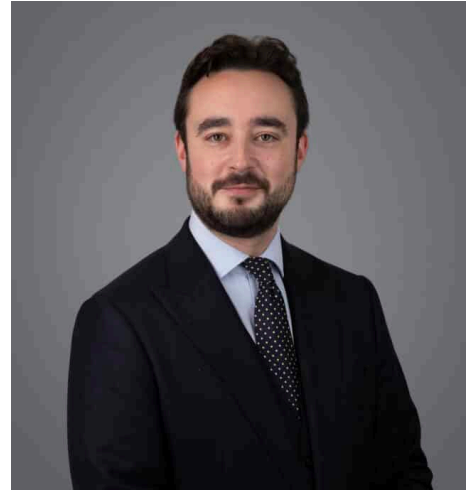

Tom is a highly regarded barrister specialising in clinical negligence, inquests & inquiries, industrial disease and personal injury litigation. Those specialisms are fortified by his significant experience in commercial dispute resolution, costs and insurance work. He was appointed directly to the Attorney General's Regional B Panel in 2023.

Industrial Disease

Industrial disease work forms a large part of Tom's personal injury practice, where he is ranked as a leading junior by the Legal 500. He regularly acts for claimants and defendants dealing with all issues (including medical causation, breach of duty and limitation) in claims relating to occupational asthma, asbestos-related disease, occupational stress, COSHH, noise-induced hearing loss and work-related upper limb disorders.

Claims arising from exposure to chemicals are a particular interest, given Tom's background, as are technical factual and legal arguments on causation.
