He holds a law degree from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Greece) and an LL.M in International and European Trade Law from Leicester University, England. He is a member of the Athens Bar Association and he was called on 1996 after serving the Greek Air force for twenty months as judicial assistant. He was promoted to appointed lawyer before the Greek Supreme Court on 2004. For the last twenty years, he gets instructed on cross border cases involving personal injury claims of foreign and Greek citizens. He is a founding member of PEOPII and a member of APIL and IETL. He was instructed on many significant cases involving British Tourists including cases ΑΠ525/2010, 581/2010 and he managed to overturn Greek Supreme's Court jurisprudence on the ability of British citizens to claim Greek damages on road fatalities in Greece, and lately on case 246/2016 on the Applicable law on cases involving foreign Tourists. He regularly acts as a Greek Law expert before the Courts of England and Wales and he was actively involved in several cases including *Panagaki v Minetta SA General Insurances*: Judgment 14 May 2015, reported Lawtel 15 May 2015, *Moreno vs Mib*, UKSC 2015/0113 and many others. He is fluent in Greek, English and Italian.
